Trinity's Biblical garden continues to be a lush and lasting legacy to the church and to our community. Since 1973 it has been an outdoor sanctuary of beauty, peace and tranquility. The garden is designed for you to walk through and rediscover the Bible, by way of plants trees and herbs.

CREATION On the 6th Day of Creation - God's work was finished; and He declared it very good. Look around and enjoy God's gift of creation and the beauty of this garden.

Genesis 2:15 "The Lord God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to work and take care of it."



MOSES WAY continues the story of Genesis through Deuteronomy. It includes the Original Sin, exile from the Garden of Eden, the Exodus from Egypt and the giving of the Ten Commandments.

While strolling the pathway, notice the markers of herbs and tress that are mentioned in the Bible, many you may recognize.

said," I give you every seed -bearing plant on the face of the whole earth and every tree that has fruit with seed in it. They will be yours for food."




The back wall and pathway is intended to be a living history of the plants and trees that are mentioned in the Old Testament. HEBREW HISTORY - is covered in books of Joshua through Esther. **POETRY LANE** - Job through Song of Solomon are known as the poetry section and songbook of the Old Testament. PROPHET'S PATHWAY - God choose 16 prophets to teach the Hebrew Nation. Many prophets used plants and trees in prophesizing good or bad times. The period of the prophets is covered in the books of Isaiah through Malachi.



JACOB'S WELL

John 4:6 "...and Jesus, tired as he was from the journey, sat down by the well it was about noon"



APOSTLES CORNER is an outdoor learning center where young and old can learn about the old Testament prophets, the 12 disciples, the Apostle Paul and John the Baptizer.



Psalm 23, "The Lord is my shepherd, I lack nothing. He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside quiet waters, he refreshes my soul. "

The BRIDGE represents the 400 years (the Apocrypha) between the last prophet of the Old Testament, Malachi, and the birth of the promised Messiah, Jesus Christ in the first book of the New Testament, Matthew.



The ROSE GARDEN symbolizes God's love for us.
