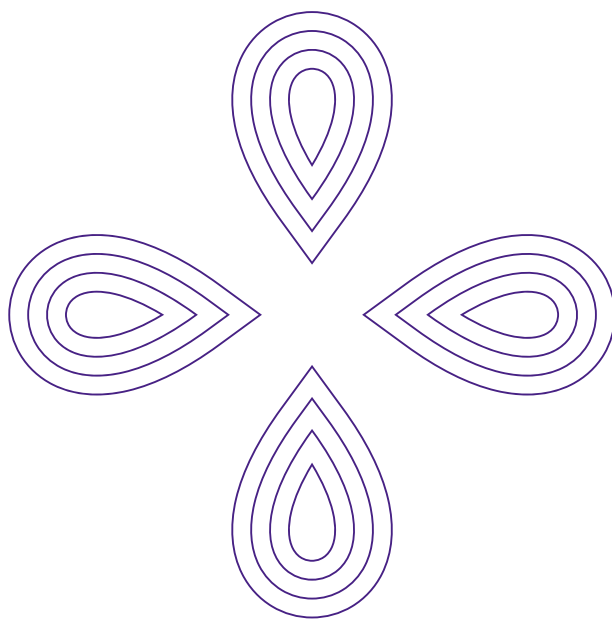
WHO CAN ATTEND CAMP?

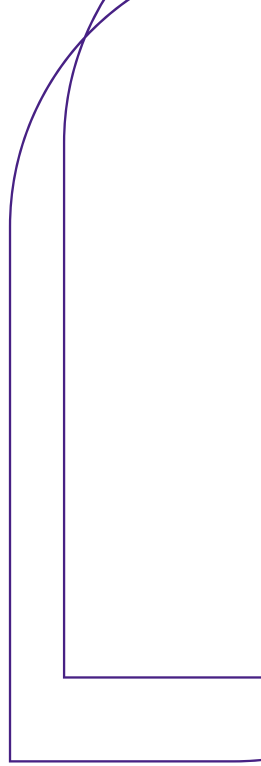

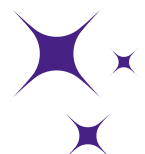
Helpful Summer Camp Tips
